## *How to Plan the Perfect Bachelorette Party! (And have fun while doing it!)*

Hey Girl! So the time has finally come! It's time to gather all the bridesmaids and throw a party that your bachelorette will cherish for the rest of her life. This is technically her last night as a single gal and you want to make sure that she has the time of her life. We know this can be a stressful feat. Getting a group of girls to agree on anything can be mind numbing, so we here at *That Bachelorette Show* have put together a little guide to help you and your girls have a stress-free and all around incredible Bachelorette Party!



## Step One – Envision the Perfect Party (4 months until party time)

### Dream Big

- Ask yourself: "What makes the perfect Bachelorette Party?"
- Make a wish list of things that you want at the party.
- Use your imagination, think outside of the box, and make this a unique experience.

## Step Two – Brainstorm the Perfect Party (3 months until party time)

### Discuss potential dates

- You want to pick a date that the bride doesn't have anything else planned. How horrible would it be for her to have to wake up from a crazy girls' night out only to have a hangover at brunch with her future in-laws? You also want to make sure that she doesn't have anything pressing happening the day of the party like dress fittings or hair/makeup consultations. You want the party to be as stress-free as possible.

### Come up With a Guest List

- Have the bride jot down a list of friends that she would like to come. You don't want the bride to feel like she is planning the party, but you do want to make sure that all of the people that she wants there are invited. Make sure you have the name, phone number, mailing and email address of each invitee. If the bride doesn't have this information, don't pester her to find it. Ask her mom or other friends. All of the bridesmaids must be invited, even if you know they won't be able to come. You might also consider inviting female family members of the bride or groom that are around the same age, other close friends of the bride in the area, and any other wedding participants (i.e. candle lighters, guest table attendants, readers, etc.). The more the merrier!

## Step Three – Plan the Perfect Party (3 months until party time)

### Invitations

- Send out the initial invite to get a head count of who will be coming. This should include general information about the night (date, time, place, general cost info., etc.) Make sure you include detailed RSVP information.



### Party Favors

- Purchase any bachelorette party favors and decorations at this time.

## Step Four – Reserve the Perfect Party (2 months until party time)

### Reservations

- Make reservations with any restaurants, limousines, night clubs, hotels, etc. Make sure to get their cancellation policy, should something happen last minute. Make sure to reserve for the minimum amount of people that you know will be there! Often times, you are allowed to add to your reservation, but not take away, which could leave you with a bill to foot!



## **Step Five – Confirm the Perfect Party** *(1 month until party time)*

### Final Invite

- This should include all of the details of the party.
  - date
  - time
  - place
  - meeting time and place
  - final amount to be paid
  - whom to pay and by what date
  - maps
  - itinerary



### Confirmation

- Confirm your reservation at all venues and make any last minute additions to the reservations.

## **Step Six – Finalize the Perfect Party** *(2 weeks until party time)*



### Final Call

- Call those procrastinating friends of yours and remind them that the time to pay is now!

## **Step Seven – Gear Up for the Perfect Party** *(1 week until party time)*

### Final E-Mail

- Send out an exciting email to pump the girls up about the upcoming party.
- Start dropping hints to the bachelorette about how much fun her last night out as a single lady is going to be!



## **Step Eight – Enjoy the Perfect Party** *(party time!)*

### Prepare for your Party

- Decorate for the party.
- Take a nap. (very important)
- Eat a good meal.
- Deal with last minute details.
- Get ready to PARTY!

## **Step Nine – Clean up the Perfect Party** *(the morning after)*

### Wrap Everything Up

- Send thank you notes to all the attendees.
- Collect any last minute payments.
- Tip the appropriate parties.

## **Step Ten – You Did It!**

- Give yourself a pat on the back for your stellar planning skills!
- Get ready for the wedding!



## Bachelorette Party Month by Month Checklist

### 4 months away from the party

- Discuss potential dates
- Develop a guest list
- Choose the type of party
- Start to research venues

### 3 months away from the party

- Send out initial invites
- Purchase party favors and décor

### 2 months away

- Make reservations

### 1 month away

- Send out final invitations
- Confirm all reservations

### 2 weeks away

- Finalize all plans

### 1 week away

- Send out reminder e-mail to attendees

### Day of the Party

- Decorate
- Take a nap
- PARTY!!!

### After the party

- Send out thank you notes
- Collect overdue payments
- Tip the appropriate vendors

## Money Saving Tips

- Book in advance - Often times, vendors will offer discounts if you book several months in advance.
- Go All inclusive - Some vendors will offer to plan your entire party for you for a discount. *That Bachelorette Show* is one of them!
- Buy in bulk - Buy party favors in bulk. It's better to buy a lot and use them for the next party you have to throw!
- Ask about specials - Open bar packages or pre-arranged menus are cheaper than a la carte!
- Get help - Bridesmaids are usually more than welcome to pick up part of the tab.
- Look for discounts - Search online for discount coupons to help with the price.
- Get Creative - Make your own party favors.
- Invite more people - Group rates are usually cheaper.



## *Bachelorette Party Dos and Don'ts*

- DO plan at least a month in advance
- DO kick back with a drink to help you relax
- DO allow for ample travel time to venues
- DO have others help you out with the cost
- DO consider ideas from friends
- DO show the bride a great last night out
- DO come up with a reasonable budget



- DON'T wait until the last minute
- DON'T drink too much
- DON'T eat too much at dinner
- DON'T be late
- DON'T let others dictate
- DON'T let the bride pay for herself
- DON'T embarrass the bride too much
- DON'T involve the bride in "party drama"
- DON'T ask party goers to pay TOO much
